

RESOLUTION 2012-01

PREVAILING WAGE RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the State of Illinois has enacted “An Act regulating wages of laborers, mechanics, and other workers employed in any public works by the State, County, City or any public body or political subdivision or by anyone under contract for public works,” approved June 26, 1941, as amended, codified as 820 ILCS 130/0.01 et seq.; and

WHEREAS, the aforesaid Act requires that the public bodies investigate and ascertain the prevailing rate of wages as defined in said Act for laborers, mechanics, and other workers in the locality of said governmental agencies employed in performing construction of public works, for said agencies;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of Highland Hills Sanitary District, as follows:

SECTION 1: To the extent and as required An Act regulating wages of laborers, mechanics, and other workers employed in any public works by the State, County, City or any public body or political subdivision or by anyone under contract for public works,” approved June 26, 1941, as amended the general prevailing rate of wages in this locality for laborers, mechanics, and any other workers engaged in construction of public coming under the jurisdiction of the agencies listed below is hereby ascertained to be the same as the prevailing rate of wages for construction work in DuPage county area as determined by the Department of Labor of the State of Illinois as of June, 2012, a copy of that determination being attached hereto labeled **Exhibit “A”** and incorporated herein by reference. The definition of any terms appearing in this Resolution, which are also used in the aforesaid Act, shall be the same as in the Act.

SECTION 2: Nothing herein contained shall be construed to apply said general prevailing rate of wages as herein ascertained to any work or employment except public works construction of the agencies listed below to extent required by the aforesaid Act.

SECTION 3: The District shall publicly post or keep available for inspection by any interested party in the main office of each this determination of such prevailing rate of wages.

SECTION 4: The District shall mail a copy of this determination to any employer, and to any association of employers and to any person or association of employees who have filed their names and addresses, requesting copies of any determination stating the particular rates and the particular class of workers whose wages will be affected by such rates.

SECTION 5: The Secretary shall file a certified copy of this Resolution with both the Secretary of State and the Department of Labor for the State of Illinois.
