

ORDINANCE 2012-01

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 2005-02 AND ESTABLISHING A SURCHARGE FOR UNCORRECTED VIOLATIONS

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of Highland Hills Sanitary District have heretofore passed Ordinance 2005-02, which was later amended by Ordinance 2009-02, and Ordinance 2010-04;

WHEREAS, The Board of Trustees of Highland Hills Sanitary District deem it appropriate to further amend Ordinance 2005-02 to incorporate a surcharge for any uncorrected violation of any Ordinance of Highland Hills Sanitary or violation of any rule or regulation the Illinois or United States Environmental Protection Agency;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the PRESIDENT and the BOARD OF TRUSTEES of the HIGHLAND HILLS SANITARY DISTRICT, DuPage County, that Ordinance 2005-02 is hereby amended as follows:

**SECTION 1.** That Section 2 of Ordinance 2005-02 is hereby amended to read as follows:

**SECTION 2.** Said rates and charges for service shall be payable bi-monthly. The Owner of the premises, the occupant thereof and the user of the services shall be jointly and severally liable to pay for the service on such premises. The service is furnished to the premises by the DISTRICT upon the condition that the Owner of the premises, occupant and user of the services are jointly severally liable thereof to the DISTRICT. All bills for service shall be rendered as of the 30th day of the month succeeding the period for which the service is billed and shall be payable not later than the close of business on the 28th day following the date of the bill. If payment of the full amount of the bill is not made within said period, then a penalty of \$35.00 shall be added thereto.

In addition to the rates set forth in Section 1 of Ordinance 2010-04 any customer who has been given notice of any uncorrected violation shall be subject to a surcharge of \$50.00 for each bill issued by the District."

**SECTION 2.** A copy of this Ordinance, properly certified by the Clerk of the District, shall be filed in the office of the Recorder of Deed of DuPage County, and shall be deemed notice to all owners of real estate of their liability for service supplied to any user of sewerage system.

**SECTION 3.** All ordinances are parts thereof in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

**SECTION 4.** That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and publication as provided by law.
